F League Specific Rules

- Each team will consist of seven players on the field; one must be a goalkeeper. A minimum of six players will be required in order for a team to take the field.
- There are four (4) 15 minute quarters. There will be a 3 minute break between quarters and a 5-8 minute break between halves. For inclement weather or impending darkness, the length of each quarter may be shortened by mutual agreement of the referee(s) and the coaches.
- A size 4 (11-13 ounce) soccer ball is used.
- An improper throw-in will result in ball being given to the opposition for a throw-in from the same place.
- Cannot score directly from a kickoff.
- No penalty kicks; however, there are **direct kicks**.
- Goalkeeper's hand on the ball is possession.
- Offsides will not be called; if a player is "camped out" in front of the goal, the referee/coach should reposition the player.
- No slide tackling - Award an indirect kick

Other BSA Rules (see BSA Handbook for complete list)

- Soccer cleats are preferred for practices and games, but are not mandatory. Shoes must be either soft sole gym shoes or soft rubber molded cleat soccer shoes. Cleated baseball or football shoes with toe cleats are not permitted.
- Players are also responsible for wearing shin guards, which are mandatory equipment for participating in soccer. The socks must cover the shin guards at all times and must not have any exposed hard edges.
- Jewelry of any sort is not normally permitted, including but not limited to: earrings, necklaces, bracelets, chains, chokers, rings, pendants, pins, buttons, watches, hard plastic and metal hair combs and barrettes. Medical notification tags or bracelets are permitted. Earrings may be covered with tape.
- Players not in the game and spectators should remain at least three (3) feet back from the sidelines. No one is permitted behind the end lines.
- Inclement Weather
 - Upon notification by the Commissioner, the League Directors will then notify the coaches, who in turn will notify the players. You can call the BSA Info Line, 426-5787, for updates or go to the website www.beavercreeksoccer.com
 - Teams must report to the playing field ready to play unless officially notified of postponement. The assumption that a game is cancelled must never be made.
 - The referee has the authority to postpone a game after its start because of weather conditions. Players should wait in their cars at least 10 minutes to see if the weather clears. DO NOT LEAVE right away.
- PETS are NOT PERMITTED in the soccer complex during scheduled games. Exception will be made for animals assisting persons with disabilities. When no games are scheduled within the complex, pets are permitted, but must be kept on a leash and under control at all times. Appropriate measures must be taken to clean up after all pets. If the cleanliness of the complex is not maintained, then pets will not be allowed.

Substitutions

Both teams:

- before any goal kick
- after any goal
- after an injury

Team in possession:

****Throw in: if team in possession subs, the opposing team can too****

- Subs should wait at mid-field. This makes it easier for the referees and helps get the players on the field quicker.
