



## BSA CELTIC INFORMATION

Thank You for your interest in the BSA Celtic Soccer Club, a part of the Beaver Creek Soccer Association. Here is information regarding fees, uniforms and club volunteer expectations.

**FEES:** \$420 for U8-U14. This fee is the basic fee for one full year of Celtic Play for league and training. Each team will meet with the parents during tryouts and immediately after team selection to review areas of additional expense. There is a limited amount of funds available each year for scholarships of partial fees requiring requests and supportive documentation.

1. Celtic Basic Fee: \$420 for U8-U14. These fees include regular training sessions with the club trainers, fees to participate in the MVYSA league, referee fees, coaches and players cards, coach license training, phone message tree, spring turf field rental and equipment.
2. Tournaments: Your fee includes the Creek Classic, our home tournament, the first week of June 2009. Please see information below about volunteer time for this tournament. **Additional Tournaments:** Average in cost approx \$35 per player. The coach will review at tryouts and first meeting the number of tournaments anticipated for your team. Please recognize that these will be collected prior to registration for each tournament and that by committing to the team each player is expected to pay and play in these tournaments. Teams are encouraged to attend certain number of tournaments based upon age group guidelines- many teams go beyond these guidelines and attend a large number of tournaments – so discuss this with your coach when deciding team choices.
3. Optional winter indoor leagues: Some teams participate in one or two sessions of indoor league play from November through February. This is optional and does involve an additional fee based upon the number of kids per team and the indoor league chosen.
4. Celtics provide optional once weekly indoor training during January and half of February. A \$40 indoor facility fee will be paid Oct 1, if you choose to participate in indoor winter training.
5. Uniform: consists of a “silky” top and shorts, a blue and a white uniform t-shirt, possibly a red tshirt and 2 pairs of socks. Approximate cost of \$90-120 and will be due when the order is placed. A Celtics soccer bag is recommended and costs and additional \$30-40 based upon size. Additional uniform accessories are available. Your coach will provide you with an order form and times will be available to try on sample uniforms. An additional uniform order will be done prior to spring season. Club spirit wear hoodies and gear will be offered periodically throughout the year.

PAYMENT PLAN : The Celtic Club has a 3 Tier Payment Plan.

1. July 30: Pay to the “BSA Celtic” \$210 + separate checks for Fall uniform + Separate check for any spiritwear ordered for fall
2. October 1: Pay to the “BSA Celtic” \$210 + optional \$40 indoor facility fee (if Planning to participate in 6 wks of indoor training Jan-mid Feb)
3. April 1: Pay to “BSA Celtic” any spring uniform or spiritwear orders
4. Tournament and Indoor league fees : as needed

This plan is designed to spread out the costs and help you plan when to have your payments in to your coaches. Tournaments fees per tournament will be paid as coaches request based on registration deadline dates.

Please see your coaches upfront and early and talk to them openly if you have financial concerns. We ask our players to be committed to their team and some teams do fundraising to help defer costs. The coaches can only know what is needed if you talk to them.

**VOLUNTEERS:** This organization is operated by volunteers-including you. It takes everyone of us to make it work. A team volunteer coordinator will be appointed after team formation and will coordinate with the club volunteer coordinator during the year.

1. Creek Classic Tournament: This is our home tournament. It is the first weekend on June. Every player’s family is required to work a 4 hour shift at the Creek. This is your clubs home tournament of the year and the team fee is waived because you are working this tournament. The coaches are expected to work the evening of Creek Classic signin. The team, as a courtesy, usually covers the coaches work shift the weekend of Creek classic to allow them coaching preparation time.
2. Fall/Spring Field Cleanup: This is for yard work, painting and general field maintenance. Each player’s family will be expected to work either once in the fall or once in the spring, on the designated day. Please sign in when working to receive credit for this. You are the ones who keep our complex beautiful.
3. Team Volunteer: Everyone should have a part in your team. Examples include team treasurer, volunteer coordinator, tournament t-shirt person, hotel reservation coordinator, photographer, statistician, uniform coordinator, and party coordinator. The coaches are volunteers and should coach, everyone else helps. YOU make the team and this club and we THANK YOU for all you do!!
