Welcome to the Beavercreek Soccer Association's (BSA) Recreation League. Our goal is to have fun and to teach soccer skills in a healthy atmosphere of good sportsmanship and teamwork.

This is a recreational program that is open to children in the Beavercreek area and neighboring communities, who meet the grade and age guidelines, and **who are not participating in an organized select or club soccer program.**

In order that your child is placed in the most appropriate league, carefully review the following information before you register. **Soccer players are assigned to leagues according to grade and gender, not necessarily by school (see chart below).**

(The player must be 5 years old by 9/30/10 to enroll for the fall season or by 3/30/11 for the spring season.)

NOTE: Starting in the first grade, girls have their choice of playing in either the coed or girls leagues. Please note that your daughter may be the only girl on her team in a coed league.

PLACEMENT: The BSA attempts to accommodate as many players as possible and will maintain waiting lists to form additional teams if there are enough players and volunteer coaches.

SCHEDULES:

FALL 2010: Tues Sep 7 thru Thurs Oct 21

Expect a coach to contact players by late August.

SPRING 2011: (Tentative) Sat 2 Apr thru Sat 21 May (excluding Sat 23 Apr – Easter)

PLAY WITH REQUESTS: The BSA will try to accommodate one request to play with another child if space allows and each requests the other. **The requests must be reciprocal.** Requests for coaches may be considered but will not be guaranteed.

REFUNDS: No refunds will be issued after the player completes their first game. Requests for refunds must be in writing and sent to the Registrar.

PLEASE VOLUNTEER: The Beavercreek Soccer Association is a private organization and is run by its volunteers and parents. Hundreds of people are needed to operate and maintain this program which continues to grow every year. You are joining the finest and largest soccer program in the area (over 1700 enrolled players). The BSA depends on parents to support this fine program by volunteering their time in various capacities throughout the soccer seasons.

Notice to Volunteers: Pursuant to Section 109.575. Ohio Revised Code. Ohio Revised Code Sections 109.574 through 109.577, which became effective in 2001, requires that we provide Notice to all of this organization's volunteers who may have unsupervised access to a child. The Notice provides that at any time, the volunteer might be required to provide a set of impressions of the volunteer's fingerprints, and a criminal records check might be conducted with respect to that volunteer. The law provides this organization the option, but does not require that fingerprinting and background criminal checks be conducted upon such volunteers.
