										K League Rules <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Size 3 ball used • 7v7 play • One player from each team per square on the field. • Player must stay in assigned square and may not move out of square until rotated to new square. Except players kicking on goal may enter goalie box to continue play on ball. • 2 - 25 minute halves with 3-5 min. halftime. Each half split into five separate 5-minute periods where players will be rotated between squares after each 5 minute period. • Only allowed one coach from each team on field during play. • No referees. Coaches will make all calls. 								
										Other BSA Rules (see BSA Handbook for complete list) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Soccer cleats are preferred for practices and games, but are not mandatory. Shoes must be either soft sole gym shoes or soft rubber molded cleat soccer shoes. Cleated baseball or football shoes with toe cleats are not permitted. • Players are also responsible for wearing shin guards, which are mandatory equipment for participating in soccer. The socks must cover the shin guards at all times and must not have any exposed hard edges. • Jewelry of any sort is not normally permitted, including but not limited to: earrings, necklaces, bracelets, chains, chokers, rings, pendants, pins, buttons, watches, hard plastic and metal hair combs and barrettes. Medical notification tags or bracelets are permitted. Earrings may be covered with tape. • Inclement Weather <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upon notification by the Commissioner, the League Directors will then notify the coaches, who in turn will notify the players. You can call the BSA Info Line, 426-5787, for updates or go to the website www.beavercrekssoccer.com • Teams must report to the playing field ready to play unless officially notified of postponement. The assumption that a game is cancelled must never be made. • The referee has the authority to postpone a game after its start because of weather conditions. Players should wait in their cars at least 10 minutes to see if the weather clears. DO NOT LEAVE right away. • PETS are NOT PERMITTED in the soccer complex. Exception will be made for animals assisting persons with disabilities.
